

## Longhorn PTO Meeting Minutes

November 3, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm with 4 members in attendance. We also had a visitor - Katy Barth from the Maryville Daily Forum.

1. Treasurer Report – Current balance \$7,123.21. This includes a revenue of \$376.00 for the 5 K. Deductions last month include \$556.00 for 5K shirts; 150.00 to purchase mat for Cheerleaders; 38.00 for one student to take ACT; 161.20 for Art Supplies; and 300.00 for the Media Guy Presentation.
2. Carnival - The FBLA and FFA will be hosting the carnival on Friday November 14<sup>th</sup>. The PTO will be auctioning off classroom baskets and a Basketball game. The elementary students are busy collecting items for the baskets.
3. Teacher Appreciation –

  - b. Debbie Bennett has offered to organize the Staff Freezers Meal for Christmas. She will let us know a time and date for assembling.

4. A request from PAT – Heidi Klamm Parents As First Teachers Representative requested 20.00 a month to help cover the cost of supplies for her group meetings. She told us that she is currently visiting 10 families in the South Nodaway School District and her group meetings have been very successful. Her September meeting she had 16 kids and at her October group meeting there were 32 kids in attendance. She has a Reptile Program planned for November and is expecting even more to come.
